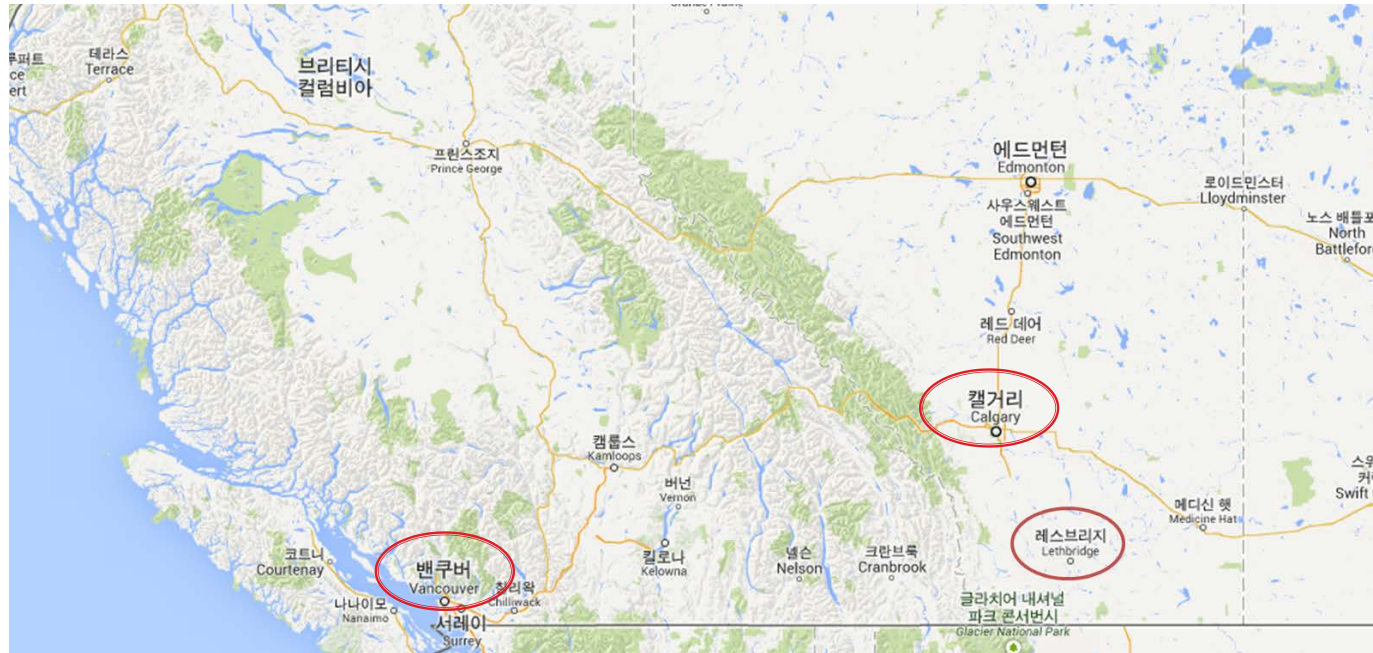

● ESL (English Language Program) & Afternoon Activities

- ✓ **ESL:** The ESL component is 4 hours/day.
Classes are interactive, and require student participation.
The group is split between two classes, depending on English level.
- ✓ **Morning:** Classes focus on communication, although all skills are used, for 3 hours in the morning.
- ✓ **Afternoon:** Students can come together for a combined class for one hour in the afternoon to learn the language to be used for the afternoon activities and/or for cultural discussions or activities.
(including Peer Partners who are Canadian undergraduate students)

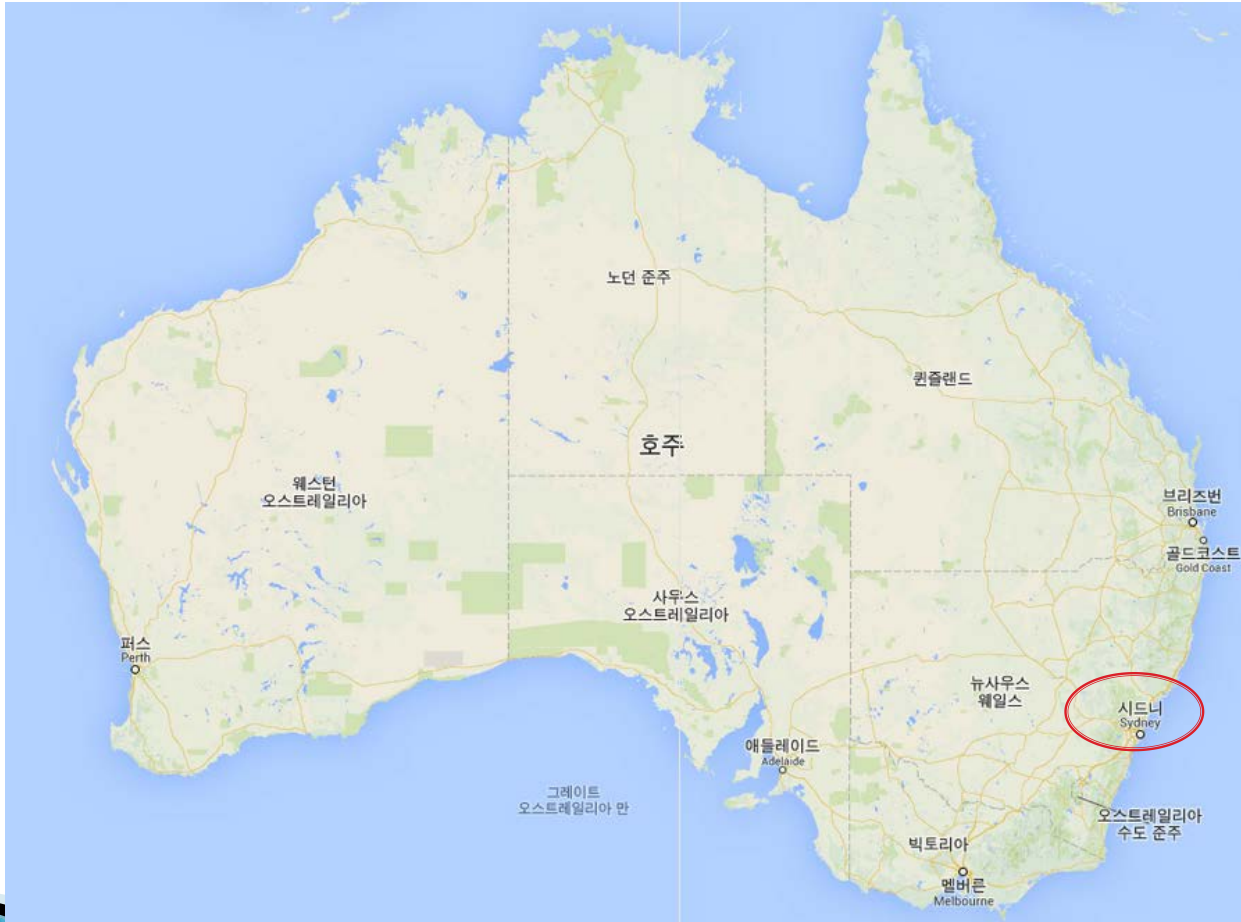

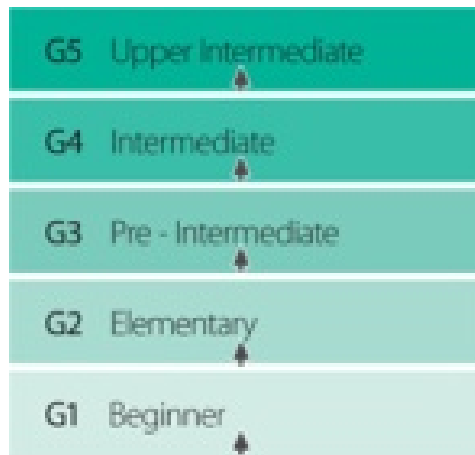

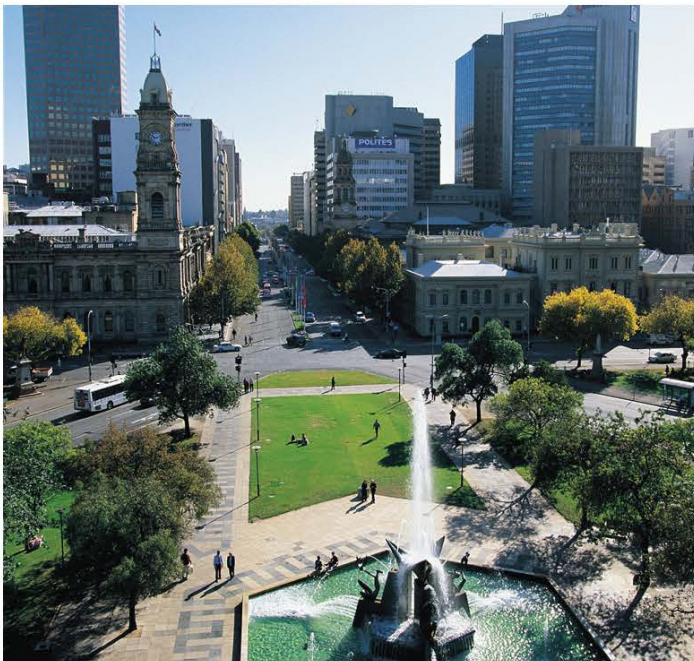
