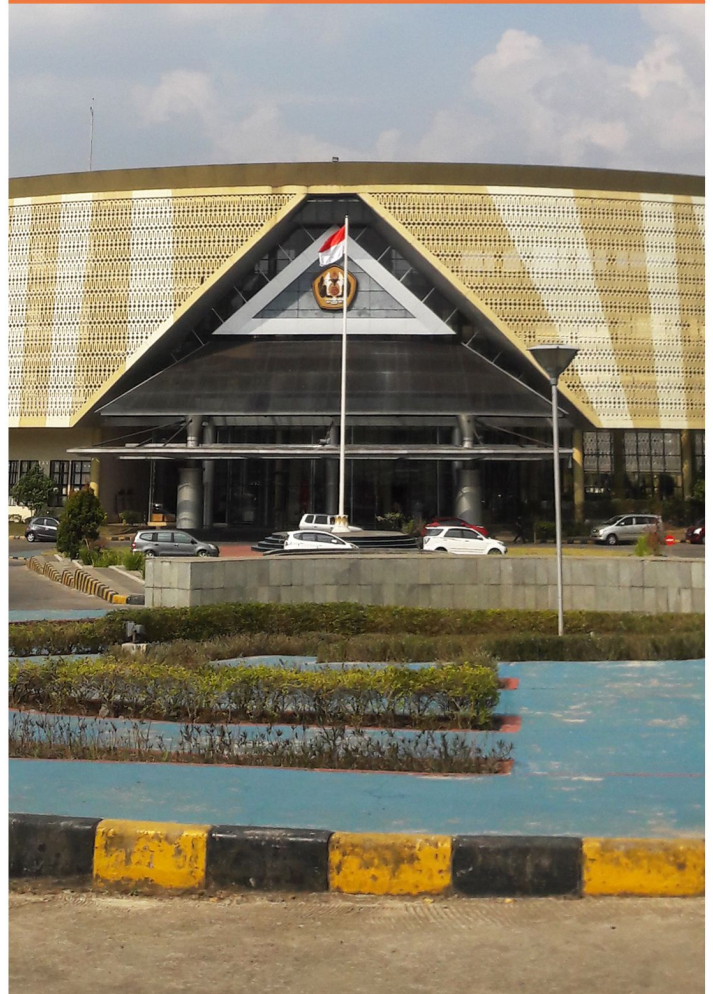

Student Exchange Program

As an implementation of Unpad's cooperation with partner universities from all over the world, students of Unpad and our partner universities can have the opportunity to participate in an exchange program that allows students to study at a partner university for one or two semesters.

The Unpad student exchange program is a program offered for partner university students or Unpad students who meet the qualification set by Unpad and the chosen partner university. Unpad students who are interested in participating in the program must apply through the Unpad International Office.

Due to the agreement, students who participate in this program are exempted from the tuition fees in the partner university. The credits of the courses taken from the partner university could be transferred to Unpad based on the approval of the students' department and faculty and vice versa.

■ Free Mover

- Students from partner universities but not officially nominated by home universities. In this case, the student(s) still has to apply through their home university as a self-funded exchange student.
- Students from universities which do not have an exchange agreement with Unpad yet.

■ Exchange Program Overview

- Based on Agreement
- Conducted every semester and may be carried out for one to two semesters (depending on the agreement)
- Student(s) must be firstly nominated by home university
- The programs are mainly in Bahasa Indonesia, but there are classes taught in English under international programs that are available at a number of faculties

■ Requirements For Student Exchange

Here are the application materials needed to apply for the student exchange program:

- Guarantor for Financial Support
- Personal Statement
- Curriculum Vitae
- Scanned copy of passport, must be valid for at least 24 months.
- Scanned copy of passport cover
- Nomination letter from home university
- Copy of academic records and diplomas
- Copy of language certificate (one of the following)
 - TOEFL: 550 (paper-based); IELTS: no less than 5.5; iBT: minimum 70
- Good health statement from applicant's doctor
- Passport-size photograph

Unpad Summer Program

Unpad summer program is an event which focuses on intercultural communication. This is an annual 14-day program which consists of cultural activities, lectures, and workshops. The objective of this program is to promote friendship across nations while exploring the culture and the beauty of West Java. At least fifty students from around the globe, mainly ASEAN member states and China, participate in this event every year. Anyone can join this program as registration is open to the public.



BIPA Unpad (Bahasa Indonesia Language Course)

BIPA Unpad is an Indonesian Language Learning Program for Foreign Speakers held at Universitas Padjadjaran. This program is addressed to foreigners that want to learn the Indonesian language. The BIPA teaching program has been running since 1980. Currently, the BIPA Program is under the Language Center, Faculty of Cultural Sciences, Universitas Padjadjaran.

Course Program

The Course of Indonesian for Speakers of Foreign Languages consists of two programs: the regular and non-regular programs.

a. Regular Program

There are four levels in this program: Elementary (Beginner's) Level, Intermediate Level, Advanced Level, and Upper Advanced Level. Each level is taught within a period of one semester. Before taking a program, a participant must take a placement test.

Course materials include vocabulary, grammar, listening, reading, writing, and speaking. Fieldwork courses and cultural excursions are also parts of the program. In addition, the course also includes general lectures on Indonesian Studies, which discuss a wide range of social, cultural, political, and historical topics on Indonesian and Sundanese cultures. Classes are taught on weekdays (Monday through Friday), from 8:30 to 11:45 am, with a 15-minute break. All class meetings are conducted at Unpad Dipatiukur Bandung Campus.

Regular course fee is IDR 10,000,000.00 per semester, modules included.
The Registration fee is IDR 250,000.00.

Accommodation

Upon request, foreign students can be placed with Indonesian families selected by the Language Center. Home-stay fees are terms and conditions dependent. The Language Center provides information on accommodations or boarding houses available around the campus.



b. Non-Regular Program

1) Intensive Courses

Intensive courses are held according to participants' interests, with at least a 40-hour package.

The subject matter in this intensive course is the same as the regular course but there are no fieldwork courses unless the participants are interested. Intensive course participants can accommodate 5-10 people.

Course fee for the **40 hour** package:

The fees include module fees but exclude field work course fees.

2) Private Courses

The minimum length for private courses is 40 hours. Materials and modules are adjusted to the participants' needs.

The Private course fee is **IDR 200,000.00** per hour.

c. Sundanese Course Programs

BIPA also offers Sundanese Course Programs. Classes are taught by lecturers of the Sundanese Study Center, Faculty of Cultural Sciences, Universitas Padjadjaran.

The aim of the program is to provide participants with knowledge and training of the Sundanese language and culture. Course materials are focused on the Sundanese language and culture as part of the entire Indonesian culture.

Types of programs, course fees, and location of classes are the same as those of the programs offered in the course of Indonesia for Speaker of Foreign Language.

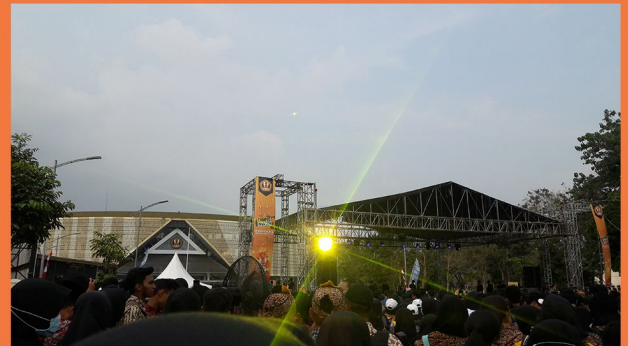

International Office

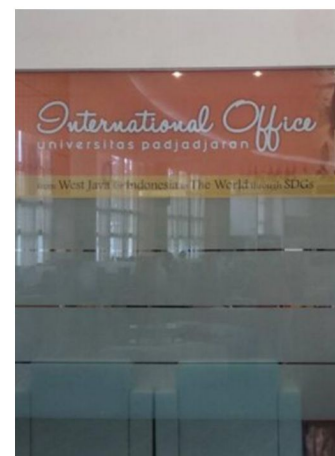

International Day

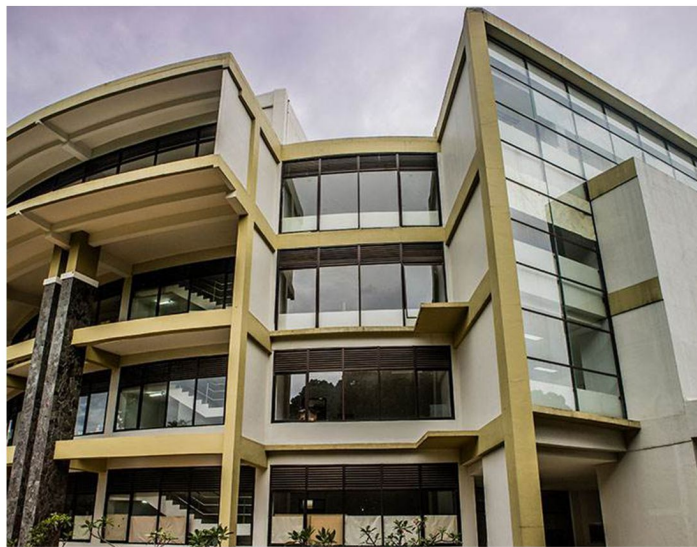

Students must pay all the necessary dormitory hall rates upfront.

Facilities

Each room is fully furnished with a desk, a wardrobe, blanket, pillow, personal bathroom, 30 kg/month laundry facilities, and 24-Hour Wifi Access. Additional communal facilities include a kitchen, study room, television, security, canteen, digital printing, gym, karaoke room, and free bike rentals available for dormitory students.

Daily Transport : Rp 10,000 - Rp 50,000 (\$1 - \$5)

Approximately Rp 100,000 – Rp 300,000/ month

Approximately Rp 50,000 – Rp 150,000 (\$4 - \$12)
(Depending on your study program)

Social activities:

Approximately Rp 100,000 – Rp 300,000/ Week (\$7 - \$20)
